



# The Westacres Tennis Club

## Rules of the Courts

Court hours - 8:00am to 11:00pm.

Courts are reserved for the exclusive use of Westacres members and for tennis use only. Trespassers will be reported to Peel Police.

All members and guests are expected to adhere to the club's rules and code of conduct as outlined here. Failure to do so may result in the individual's membership privileges being revoked.

All members are issued a key on a lanyard and are expected to have lanyard in their possession at all times. Keys are not permitted to be loaned to anyone. A \$5 fee per replacement key/lanyard.

Courts are run on a first come first serve basis. If both courts are in use, players on the court should finish their set/game (not to exceed 25 minutes) and then offer the courts to those waiting. Doubles do not have priority over singles.

Members are welcome to bring guests, but only limited to two (2) times per season. Guests must be accompanied on court by a member.

Tennis and sports attire must be worn at all times with "non marking" tennis shoes. Any improper shoes will not be allowed inside the courts.

Members are responsible for locking/closing the club's gate at all times.

If both courts are in use, members should respect the players on the other court and not interrupt the game of play to retrieve a ball.

Players are expected to respect the rights of other players. Shouting, swearing, heckling, etc., should not occur or be permitted.

Any noise complaints received by residents or by other members will result in immediate suspension of membership privileges.

Alcohol and/or smoking consumption is absolutely prohibited within tennis courts.

Members are responsible for recycling/disposing of any water bottles, metal tops to your cans and/or litter in bins located on the outside of the courts.

No pets are allowed inside the tennis court premises.

Members are to report any suspicious activity around the club to a member of the Executive.

Members assume all risks in using the courts at Westacres Tennis Club. If the courts are not safe due to moisture, leaves, etc... it is the member's decision to use sound judgment whether to play or not.

Westacres Tennis Club is not responsible or liable for any personal injuries/equipment damages incurred during the outdoor season. Failure to abide by the above rules will result in disciplinary action by the club which could result in membership being revoked or suspended.

Any personal information you provide to Westacres Tennis Club Tennis Club will be used by Westacres Tennis Club Tennis Club's Executive, its volunteers for the purpose of conveying membership information to you. You can be rest assured that your information will be held in total confidence in compliance with the Personal Information Protection and Electronics Documents Act ("PIPEDA") which became effective January 1, 2004 and not be shared with any external affiliates or partners with the exception of the City of Mississauga upon request.

Westacres Tennis Club reserves the right to amend rules and policies in response to changing circumstances, or for any other reason. Membership will be notified of any major changes either by email, in person or by phone.
